Who We Are

Public Allies' mission is to create a just and equitable society and the diverse leadership to sustain it.

Through our signature AmeriCorps program, Public Allies identifies talented emerging leaders from all backgrounds and prepares them for careers working towards community improvement. In our 10-month apprenticeship program you will work full-time for a non-profit or civic organization addressing critical community issues. You will also develop your own interpersonal skills through regular leadership training delivered by local leaders.

You'll gain valuable *leadership skills*, receive *personalized coaching* to pursue your career goals, *build relationships* with a large network of local leaders, and participate in a national movement of leaders working for change.

- Earn a monthly stipend of **\$2,705.30**
- Receive healthcare, childcare, and student loan deferment during your term of service.
- Earn an education award of \$7,395 to pay back student loans or pay for future education.
- Develop and practice your **leadership skills**.
- **Expand your network** of wide-ranging, passionate change makers and community leaders.
- Learn about career opportunities in the nonprofit sector.
